#### ORDER

As per the G.O. first read above Govt. had sanctioned 195 courses in Arts & Science and Training Colleges under Kerala, Mahatma Gandhi, Calicut and Kannur Universities. As per G.O. 2nd read Govt. had specified the conditions to be satisfied for starting these courses. It was ordered that there shall be no financial commitment. It was also ordered that changes of courses could be considered in cases where the courses sanctioned earlier involved financial commitment. Govt. have now received a few requests for change of the courses already sanctioned and for starting additional courses under aided and unaided colleges.

In the circumstances sanction is accorded for the change of courses as mentioned in the Appendix-I to this Govt.order.

Additional courses are sanctioned to the Colleges as mentioned in the Appendix-II to this Govt.order under Calicut and Kannur Universities considering the educational backwardness of the area served by these colleges.

Sanction is also accorded for starting of new course and B.Ed courses and as mentioned in the Appendix-III to this govt.order to unaided colleges coming under Mahatma Gandhi University. The courses sanctioned by this Govt.order will be conducted on condition that there is no financial commitment to Government. No posts shall be created or guest lecturers engaged at Govt.expenses for these courses at any point of time.

The colleges can initiate action to admit students and conduct classes if they are satisfied that there is

no financial commitment to govt. based on the assessment of workload. Cases of doubt may be referred to the Dy. Directors ~~and~~<sup>and</sup> of Collegiate Education, who may assess the workload and determine whether the courses can be conducted without expenditure to Government. There shall be no objection to expenditure on the courses being met from sources other than government.
